A LIST OF WAYS TO INTEGRATE TEEN DATING VIOLENCE EDUCATION INTO MULTIPLE SUBJECT AREAS

Subject Area	Idea
English	Read "The Breakable Vow" by Kathryn Ann Clark. Curriculum guides available.
English	Read "Speak" by Laurie Halse Anderson. Curriculum and discussion guides available.
Civics/Social Studies	Review of passage of Ohio House Bill 19, which requires schools to offer teen dating violence prevention. Review Tina's story and how bill becomes a law.
Theology	Review teen dating violence as it relates to social justice and morality.
Math/Economics	Calculate the financial cost of domestic violence on our country.
Math/Statistics	Take a critical look at the statistics citing the prevalence of teen dating violence, domestic violence and sexual violence. Review how both sides of the political spectrum cite or criticize these statistics to support their own agenda. ()
Art	An introduction to the use and effectiveness of art therapy with trauma survivors.
Writing	Introduction to teen dating, domestic and sexual violence followed by journaling assignments.
Drama/Theatre Arts	Role playing scenarios to help teens recognize behavior and discuss and develop responses.
